Now, Keep It!*

You could be eligible for up to \$5,600 through the Earned Income Tax Credit.

See if you are eligible and claim the Earned Income Tax Credit.

Who qualifies for the EITC? You must have worked in 2009 and your annual income is below:

- **\$43,279** for taxpayers with **3 or more children** (**\$48,279** for **married and filing jointly**) to receive a credit up to **\$5,657**.
- **\$40,295** for taxpayers with **2 children** (**\$45,295** for **married and filing jointly**) to receive a credit up to **\$5,028**.
- **\$35,463** for taxpayers with **1 child** (**\$40,463** for **married and filing jointly**) to receive a credit up to **\$3,043**.
- **\$13,440** for taxpayers with **no child** (**\$18,440** for **married and filing jointly**) to receive a credit up to **\$457**.

## FREE Tax Preparation Help is Available

You claim the EITC on your federal tax return. To self-prepare and eFile your Federal and State tax forms for FREE, use the I-CAN!-Efile website.
