Subject: Reinstatement of SER Energy Payments

Response Due: None

Additional funding has been appropriated for energy crisis payments. Therefore, you may resume making payments for SER service codes 26, 27, 33, 63, 64 and 65 effective May 8, 2007. Previously denied applications are not to be reinstated. Previously denied clients may reapply if they still have a need.

As a reminder, SER policy requires that you only pay the amount necessary to prevent shutoff or restore service. This does not include the current charges. Current charges are not subject to shutoff until the next billing cycle is complete and the unpaid balance falls into shutoff status. This may take an additional 30-60 days depending on the number of notices sent by the provider.

We will continue to monitor this situation and allow authorizations as funding allows.
